History

Monarchs: Queen Elizabeth II vs Queen Victoria

Queen Victoria (1819-1901) was coronated in 1837. From 1837 until 1901 this was called the Victorian Era.	The two queens are the longest reigning monarchs.
Queen Elizabeth II was born in 1926. She was coronated in 1953 and is still the queen today.	Queen Victoria ruled over the British Empire.
A coronation is the official crowning of a monarch (king or queen).	Queen Elizabeth II is the head of the commonwealth, church and the armed forces.
