## **Safeguarding**

Any adult who works in school has a DBS. This ensures that all adults that the children come into contact with whilst in the school have this check in place. A DBS check is a background check on a person's criminal record, commonly used to check potential employees or volunteers and assess their suitability to work in a school. This is a legal requirement of school. To ensure that this is maintained no adult should enter school without the permission from the headteacher. Please do not be offended if you are asked not to enter the building by one of the school staff. If you have any concerns or want to speak to the class teacher you should visit the office and they will help you – no parent should be escorting their child to the classroom.
